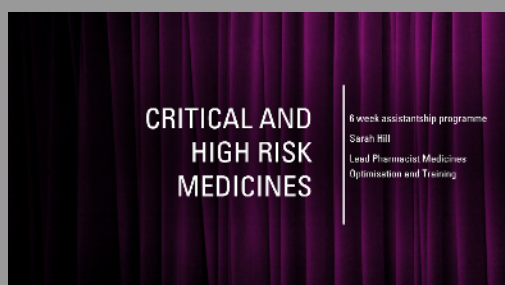
SEPSIS AND ANTIBIOTIC PRESCRIBING

Did you know that Sepsis is more common than heart attacks? Identify high risk patients, manage medicines and prescribe antibiotics using our local microbiology guidelines.



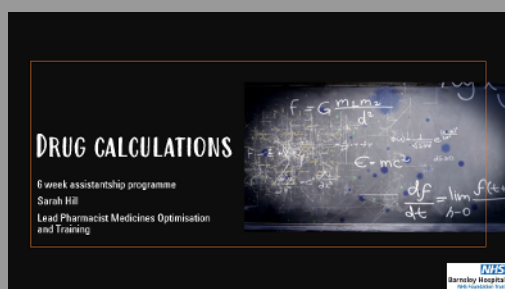
DRUG CAUTIONS AND CONTRAINDICATIONS

Combinations of some medicines can be detrimental to your patient. Learn about drugs that can't be used in patients with certain conditions or in combination with other medicines..



CRITICAL AND HIGH RISK MEDICINES

Missed critical medicines can cause patient harm so we must ensure they are prescribed and that the patient is able to take them.



DRUG CALCULATIONS

Body weight is required for calculating many drug doses in hospitals and in particular paediatrics. Tackle common drug calculations and avoid common prescribing errors.



ACUTE KIDNEY INJURY

1 in 5 patients admitted to hospital as an emergency have an AKI. Review medicines and treat complications to give patients a fighting chance of restoring their kidney function.
