How to approach prescription writing and practice writing prescription. Know about all the extra rules when prescribing controlled drugs, off-licence and unlicensed medications.



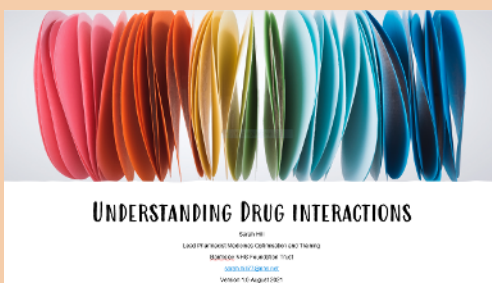
HOW TO UTILIZE THE BNF
