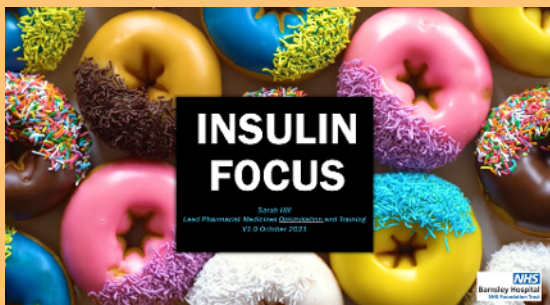
PREPARING FOR THE PSA

With over 20 different brands of insulin available on the market, you need to know the difference between each one. A high risk medicine, with no room for errors, so make sure you're up to date.



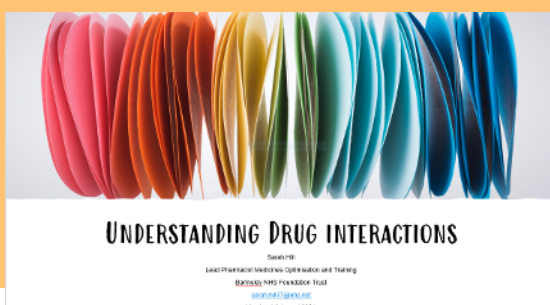
SAFE PRESCRIBING IN LIVER IMPAIRMENT
